

# SIR FAQ – English Translation

---

**1. What is the Voter List Special Intensive Revision (SIR)?**

The Election Commission of India, under Article 324 of the Indian Constitution and Section 21 of the Representation of the People Act, 1950, has directed a Special Intensive Revision. During this process, every Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) ensures that no eligible citizen is left out of the Electoral Roll and no ineligible entry remains. Before including a name, EROs will verify all eligibility details.

**2. What is the Enumeration / Verification Form?**

During SIR, if your name appears in the Voter List dated 27/10/2025, you must fill and sign the Enumeration/Verification Form to verify your details. A family member present at home may also complete and submit the form on your behalf. You will receive two copies of the form from the BLO at your residence. Alternatively, you can submit it online via <https://voters.eci.gov.in> or the ECINET mobile app.

**3. Where and how can the Enumeration/Verification Form be obtained?**

The form is available from the Booth Level Officer (BLO). Based on the voter's name, photo, address, and other details in the Electoral Roll, the BLO will deliver two copies of the form to your residence. If a voter uses the online ECINET app or the [voters.eci.gov.in](https://voters.eci.gov.in) portal, they can complete and submit the form digitally.

**4. Where should the Enumeration/Verification Form be submitted?**

After filling and signing the form, submit it with necessary documents to the BLO. If the voter is away from their residence or prefers, they may submit the form online through the ECINET app or [voters.eci.gov.in](https://voters.eci.gov.in). The signed form may also be given to the BLO through any family member.

**5. What is the last date for submitting the form?**

The last date to submit the form to the BLO or online is **4 December 2025**.

**6. How will you identify the Booth Level Officer (BLO) of your area?**

A BLO is appointed by the ERO under the instructions of the Election Commission of India. BLOs are familiar with local voters and visit homes to assist with Electoral Roll verification. You can verify their identity card issued by the Election Commission. Through the ECINET app or [voters.eci.gov.in](https://voters.eci.gov.in), clicking on "Connect with Election Officials" and entering your Voter ID will display your BLO's details. The BLO is responsible for distributing forms, collecting completed applications, and verifying them.

**7. Who is an ERO (Electoral Registration Officer) and what is their role?**

An ERO is an officer appointed by the Election Commission of India. They are

primarily responsible for preparing and maintaining the Electoral Roll of a constituency. BLOs, AEROs (Assistant EROs), and supervisors function under the ERO.

**8. How does a BLO assist voters?**

- The BLO visits your home.
- Provides two pre-filled Enumeration Forms.
- Helps you fill out the form.
- Collects the completed form and gives you an acknowledgment receipt.

**9. Is online submission of the Enumeration/Verification Form available?**

Yes. Using the ECINET mobile app or voters.eci.gov.in, voters can submit the form online using their mobile number and EPIC (Voter ID) number.

**10. What is ECINET?**

ECINET is a mobile application of the Election Commission of India. It allows voters to:

- Apply for name inclusion or correction in the Electoral Roll
- Check voter information
- File complaints
- Access election-related information, Model Code of Conduct details, and voter turnout updates

Candidates can also use it for nomination and related details.

**11. How can voters temporarily away from home submit the form?**

They may submit it online through the ECINET app or voters.eci.gov.in using their mobile number and EPIC number.

**12. What should a voter do after submitting the form?**

After publication of the Draft Electoral Roll, voters must check whether their name has been correctly included. The draft will be available with the BLO and online on ECINET and voters.eci.gov.in.

**13. When will the Draft Electoral Roll be published?**

The Draft Electoral Roll will be published on 9 December 2025.

**14. How can a voter check if their name is included in the Draft Roll?**

- (a) By checking the Electoral Roll available with the BLO
- (b) Through the ECINET mobile app using EPIC number
- (c) Through voters.eci.gov.in using EPIC number
- (d) From the Draft Roll available on the CEO West Bengal website

**15. What to do if the name is missing from the Draft Electoral Roll?**

If your name is missing, submit Form 6 with required documents to the BLO or online through the ECINET app or [voters.eci.gov.in](http://voters.eci.gov.in).

**16. When and how can a new voter apply for inclusion?**

To include a new name, fill Form 6 with required documents and submit it to the BLO, or file it online through ECINET or [voters.eci.gov.in](http://voters.eci.gov.in).
